

A Message from our Chapter President:

2018 could be defined as a year of changes, both for BI headquarters and the DC Chapter. We are in the process of synching up with the new priorities for chapters to:

1. **Establish and maintain at least one model club.** With the Model Investment Club of Northern Virginia (MicNOVA) (celebrating its 10th anniversary)), meeting on the 2nd Wednesday of each month from 7-9pm at Tyson-Pimmit Library, Falls Church, VA and the Montgomery County Model Investment Club (MCMC), meeting on the 3rd Wednesday of each month from 7-9pm at the Rockville Library, Rockville, MD, we've more than met this requirement.
2. **Participate in Money Smart Week with at least one event open to the public, free of charge.** In 2018 DC chapter partnered with Arlington library to provide a financial literacy program. We need a Money Smart Week Committee to establish a program for the week of 30 March to 6 April 2019.
3. **Support Visit-A-Club program to help the public find clubs that are open to guests who want to learn about stock investing.** Volunteer Resources has the form for clubs to request enrollment.
4. **Chapter directors making visits to BI clubs in their area.**

The DC Chapter needs the cooperation of area clubs to meet the last two requirements. Many of the club representatives that we have met reported that their membership is down due to attrition and new members are difficult to find. In addition,

individual members have contacted us for a list of clubs looking for members close to their work or home. The Visit-A-Club program can provide a bridge between those looking for members and those seeking a club.

Chapter Directors are eager to meet with club members to help you get the most from your Better Investing membership. These committed volunteers can play a vital role in your development as an informed, confident and capable investor. Would you prefer a portfolio analysis review, resources to evaluate stock ideas, or perhaps a tour of the new and helpful items on the BI website? We need feedback and an invite from our area clubs on how best to serve you.

Fewer chapter volunteers means planning smarter with less resources. Webinars and Go-To-Meeting resources allow us to provide online education and allow members far from our meeting place to follow along. We can use Go-To-Meeting to virtually visit clubs that are far outside the beltway during one of their scheduled meetings. We are encouraged by the number of regular and new visitors to monthly investment book discussions and other events. Mark Robertson - Better Returns: Founder's Wisdom and Time-Honored Lessons: Oct. 20

Better Returns: Founder's Wisdom and Time-Honored Lessons is the topic for the fall joint meeting with AAIL. Mark notes that most people and average investors are doing it wrong.
