

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

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Looking Online for Libraries with VL Online

For additional libraries:

- * Find out online if a library has a Value Line online subscription
 - * Look for a “Database” menu choice or the online catalog
- * While you're at it, check for these 2 investing databases also:
 - * Morningstar , Standard & Poor's
- * Search for libraries you might visit
 - * Check libraries in your immediate driving range first
 - * Check libraries near far-away friend/relatives you might visit
 - * Check libraries in cities you plan to tour or where you have business

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Library Card Questions

- * 1. **What is the definition of the library district?**
- Do you meet the definition of a “resident”?
- * 2. **Do you need/can you get a non-resident card?**
- Do non-residents have database privileges?
- * 3. **Is there a fee for a resident or non-resident card?**
- How long is a card good for?
- * 4. **Do you have to visit the library to get a card?**

In some cases, information on a library site is sketchy
You may have to call the library for complete answers

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


